

## LANSFORD BOROUGH COUNCIL

Special Meeting  
September 6, 2017 6:30 p.m.

A special meeting of Lansford Borough Council was held 6:30 p.m., September 6, 2017, at the borough hall, 1 W. Ridge Street, to consider recommendations from the Civil Service Commission for full time police applicants.

The meeting was called to order by Council President Martin Ditsky, the Pledge of Allegiance was recited and roll call was taken by Borough Secretary Treasurer Jill Seigendall. **John Turcmanovich made a motion to promote Lansford Police Officer Shawn Nunemacher to Sergeant effective as of this meeting. The motion was second by Jared Soto. All were in favor, motion passed.**
