

**ORDINANCE NO. 2007-09**

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING MINIMUM STANDARDS FOR THE INSTALLATION, USE AND PROPER MAINTENANCE OF ELECTRICAL SYSTEMS, INCLUDING ELECTRICAL CONTRACTORS AND EQUIPMENT WITHIN OR ON PUBLIC AND PRIVATE BUILDINGS OR OTHER STRUCTURES, CONDUCTORS THAT CONNECT TO THE SUPPLY OF ELECTRICITY AND OTHER OUTSIDE CONDUCTORS ON THE PREMISES.

THE BOROUGH COUNCIL OF THE BOROUGH OF LANSFORD DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

**SECTION 1. ADOPTION OF THE ELECTRICAL CODE.**

That a certain document, one(1) copy of which is on file in the office of the Department of Code Enforcement of the Borough of Lansford, being marked and designated as the National Electrical Code, 2005 Edition, as published by the National Fire Protection Association, be and is hereby adopted as the Electrical Code of the Borough of Lansford, in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, for the control of buildings and structures as herein provided; and each and all of the regulations, provisions, penalties, conditions and terms of National Electrical Code on file in the office of the Department of Code Enforcement of the Borough of Lansford are hereby referred to, adopted and made a part hereof, as if fully set out in this ordinance.

**SECTION 2. INCONSISTENT ORDINANCES REPEALED**

That Ordinance Number 92-1 of the Borough of Lansford, entitled the "BOCA Basic Building Code" 1990 edition and all other ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

**SECTION 3. VALIDITY**

That is any section, subsection, sentence, clause, or phrase of this ordinance is, for any reason, held to be unconstitutional, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this ordinance. The Borough of Lansford hereby declares that it would have passed this ordinance, and each section, subsection, clause or phrase thereof, irrespective of the fact that any one or more sections, subsection, sentences, clauses and phrases be declared unconstitutional.


**SECTION 4. SAVINGS CLAUSE.**

That nothing in this Ordinance or in the National Electrical code, 2005 Edition hereby adopted shall be construed to affect any suit or proceeding pending in any court, or any rights acquired, or liability incurred, or any cause or causes of action acquired or existing, under any act or ordinance hereby repealed as cited in Section 2 of this Ordinance, nor shall any just legal right or remedy of any character be lost, impaired or affected by this Ordinance.




