

LANSFORD BOROUGH
TAX LEVY ORDINANCE
ORDINANCE NO. 2017-05

An ordinance of the **BOROUGH OF LANSFORD**, County of Carbon, Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, fixing the tax rate for the year **2018**.

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED, and it is hereby ordained and enacted,

By the Borough Council of the Borough of Lansford, County of Carbon, and Commonwealth of Pennsylvania:

That a tax be, and the same is hereby levied, on all real property within the Borough of Lansford subject to taxation for the fiscal year 2018 as follows:

Tax rate for **General Purposes**, the sum of **29.00** mills on each dollar of assessed valuation, or the sum of **290.00** cents on each one hundred dollars of assessed valuation.

Tax rate for **Debt Purposes**, the sum of **1.40** mills on each dollar of assessed valuation, or the sum of **14.00** cents on each one hundred dollars of assessed valuation.

For **Parks & Recreation** purposes, the sum of **1.00** mills on each dollar of assessed valuation, or the sum of **10.00** cents on each one hundred dollars of assessed valuation.

For **Fire Protection** purposes, the sum of **0.98** mills on each dollar of assessed valuation, or the sum of **9.80** cent on each one hundred dollars of assessed valuation.

For **Lighting** purposes, the sum of **2.96** mills on each dollar of assessed valuation, or the sum of **29.60** cents on each one hundred dollars of assessed valuation.

For **Pension** purposes, the sum of **0.50** mills on each dollar of assessed valuation, or the sum of **5.00** cents on each one hundred dollars of assessed valuation.



Tax rate for <u>Debt Purposes</u>	<u>1.40</u> mills	<u>14.00</u> cents
Tax rate for <u>Parks & Recreation</u>	<u>1.00</u> mills	<u>10.00</u> cents
Tax rate for <u>Fire Protection</u>	<u>0.98</u> mills	<u>9.80</u> cents
Tax rate for <u>Lighting</u>	<u>2.96</u> mills	<u>29.60</u> cents
Tax rate for <u>Pension</u>	<u>0.50</u> mills	<u>5.00</u> cents
TOTAL	<u>35.84</u> mills	<u>358.40</u> cents

Tax Levy Ordinance 2017-05 of the Borough of Lansford, County of Carbon, Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, fixing the tax rate for the fiscal year 2018 that the tax levied on all real property within the Borough of Lansford subject to taxation as follows:

Tax rate for General purposes, the sum of 29.00 mills

Tax rate for Pension purposes, the sum of 0.50 mills

Tax rate for Debt purposes, the sum of 1.40 mills

Tax rate for Park & Recreation purposes, the sum of 1.00 mill

Tax rate for Fire protection purposes, the sum of 0.98 mills

Tax rate for Lighting purposes, the sum of 2.96 mills
