- **Fire Department:** Report from [American Fire Co. No. 1](#) regarding calls, fire escrow status, and equipment maintenance.
- **EMS / Ambulance:** Update from Lehighon Ambulance on service delivery and emergency medical response.
- **Emergency Management (EMA):** Coordination updates for upcoming events, weather preparedness, or regional safety initiatives.

5. Correspondence

- Review of any official letters, [grant notifications](#), or resident communications requiring committee action.

6. Old Business

- Follow-up on previously discussed items (e.g., oversized vehicle ordinances, security camera installations, or ongoing grant applications).

7. New Business

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- Discussion of new safety initiatives (e.g., police pension updates, Trick or Treat scheduling, or county-wide police testing consortiums).
- Motions to recommend specific actions to the full Borough Council for a final vote.
